News in brief...

Mackenzie school trustee and vice-chair Shuirose Valimohamed resigned from the board of School District 57 last week, along with board chair Trent Derrick.

This followed a special advisors report that pointed to systemic racism and lowered engagement by indigenous students in SD57 schools, as well as hierarchical decision-making and a "culture of fear" on the board.

The report notes that School District 57 has gone through five superintendents since 2015.

Staffing changes at BC **Emergency Health Services** will result in some improvements for Mackenzie Ambulance Station.

A "scheduled on-call" system will see four permanent, scheduled paramedic positions at the station, covering day shifts 7 days of the week. Previously, staff were exclusively on-call 24 hours a day, carrying a pager.

Mackenzie Ambulance station has two ambulances.

Nursing shortages have created staffing crises in hospitals throughout Northern Health. Some COVID-19 patients have had to be flown to hospitals in Vancouver and Victoria.

Health minister Adrian Dix said this week that the pressure on hospitals due to the fourth wave of coronavirus cases has led to 511 postponements of non-urgent but medically necessary surgeries.

Demolition of the former Chamber and Dental buildings on Centennial is scheduled to begin within weeks. Western Thermal & Demolition of Prince George has been contracted. The buildings will require asbestos abatement and will be removed down to their foundations.

Rec Services is eveing a federal grant that could award up to \$2.4 million in funding for green upgrades to the Rec Centre, including a solar energy installation for the roof.

The Rec Centre arena roof is currently scheduled to be replaced this fall at a cost of \$332,837, with a federal-provincial grant covering two-thirds of the total.

The District continues to decline questions about drinking water testing.

The District's annual water quality reports have shown some elevated levels of manganese in the last three years, and elevated lead in one location last year.


