Canfor mill & tenure to be sold

Canfor announced late in February a "letter of intent" to sell its Mackenzie plant, site and equipment to B.C.-based Peak Renewables, and its forest tenure to McLeod Lake Indian Band and Tsay Keh Dene Nation. The deals combined amount to \$70 million.

Peak Renewables operates several mills in B.C., including a new wood pellet mill in Fort Nelson. It is owned by Brian Fehr Group, which also partners with Iris Energy in bitcoin mining facilities.

Mackenzie RCMP had responded to a call about gunfire in the home. Several shots had been fired into the floor, according to the RCMP news release.

During the call, police found other weapons and suspected drugs but the suspect had fled. The unit from Prince George disabled the explosive with no one harmed. The suspect has been identified by police but was still at large at time of printing.

Ukrainian citizens, young and old, along with local officials have been involved in the war effort from Day One of Russia's invasion:

- Moving and spray painting over street signs to confuse Russian troops entering cities
- Circulating recipes on social media for Molotov Cocktails
- Circulated on Ukrainian social media: "All citizens of Ukraine... demand of strangers standing at crossroads, near important strategic landmarks, to

answer your question in Ukrainian..."

"Take these seeds and put them in your pockets so at least sunflowers will grow when you [die on Ukrainian soil]" - infamous remark by a Ukrainian woman confronting Russian troops.

According to news reports from Ukraine and the west, many Russian troops were told they were sent to the Ukraine border for military exercises only. Some young Russian soldiers reported being shocked at being sent into a war.

'Canfor sale'...

According to its year-end report, posted March 1. Canfor brought in a recordbreaking \$1.5 billion in net income for 2021. The company cited high lumber demand and high prices in the past year.

In other Canfor news, PPWC Local 18, the union that represents former Canfor mill workers in Mackenzie, won its arbitration with the company this

past fall, winning severance pay for the roughly 180 -190 workers laid off when Canfor ceased mill operations here in 2019, along with group termination pay.

If Facebook were real life ... (Guide for Seniors)


For those of my generation who cannot comprehend why Facebook exists:
