

Lower levels anticipated for Williston

BC Hydro is forecasting potentially low levels for Williston Reservoir this spring due to dry conditions last year that persisted into the fall.

Mike Kellett, who has taken over from Bob Gammer for Northern Community Relations, told a community meeting in January that Williston had only 80.2% of normal inflows over the past year. However, he says that much can affect the forecast, including heavier recent snow falls.

One potential concern with lower lake levels can be an increase in airborne dust.

Chamber event to honour workers

Greenhouse won't use Iris waste heat

The Omineca Growers Society won't be able to use Iris Energy's waste heat for their proposed greenhouse on Coquiwaldie Road. The group, newly formed last year, plans a commercial greenhouse on the lot next to the Bitcoin mining facility to grow local fresh produce year round.

OGS Director and cofounder Kyle Tapper did not provide details on the problem or confirm if it



was technical in nature. He said the project still plans to use the lot, which was gifted to the group by the District this fall. Tapper says the group is currently exploring other options for heat.


Iris Energy, which opened its Mackenzie facility early last year, had promoted the potential for use of the plant's waste heat at a 2021 Chamber of Commerce luncheon.

Mayor Atkinson has cited this potential as the main reason for reserving the lot next to the plant for agricultural use, and because food security is a goal identified in the Official Community Plan.

A spokesperson for the company responded to The Buzzette but said she did not yet have full details on what prevented the arrangement.
