## EV station site chosen

The parking area in front of Town Centre Mall between Hagen's and the Chamber office, called "616 Parking Lot", will become the site for a Fast Charging EV (electric vehicle) station, after Council approved the location at its March 13 meeting.

The charger was offered to the District by BC Hydro in 2021 (see Buzzette Feb 23) as part of its Public EV Infrastructure Program. According to a staff report, Hydro first approached private busi-

## Conifex to begin Bitcoin hosting

Conifex announced this month that, in partnership with Tsay Keh Dene Nation, it will provide hosting services to Bitcoin mining company Greenidge Generation at its "3-mega-watt high performance computing (HPC) site, powered by renewable energy", according to the news release.

Greenidge, headquartered in Connecticut, is a cryptocurrency data centre and power generation company.

Conifex says it will host 750 miners on behalf of Greenidge with capacity of approximately 80 PH/s (peta hashes per second). The agreement includes consideration for a potential expansion of 25MW.

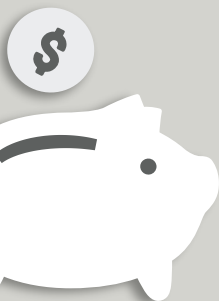

Churches, service clubs granted fees exemption

Mackenzie churches, the Elks and the Legion will not pay District water, sewer and garbage fees in a bylaw update approved by Council at the last meeting.

Council was given the option to offer a 50% discount on fees but chose to keep the full exemption for the churches and for service clubs that own their property.

Utility fees have not been paid by these groups since 2008, although the former bylaw was never officially

updated to provide an exemption.

Finance Director Kerri Borne said the cost to the community, which will not present a drop in current revenues, is \$16,500.

In discussion, council members commented that the services these groups provide far outvalue the loss in potential recouped revenues.

At the same meeting, Council approved a 7% increase for utility fees for residential and commercial customers, after no fee increases for 2022.

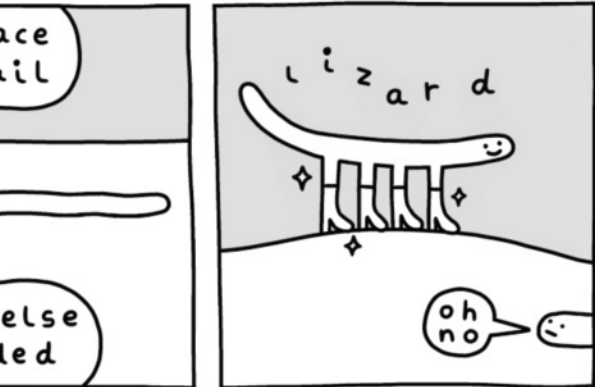
